3 **GENERAL CODE OF ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN**
4 **ORDINANCE AMENDMENT #**

6 **Ordinance Amendment offered by the Comprehensive Plan Committee**
7

8 **WHEREAS**, Section 66.1001 (4), Wisconsin Statutes, establishes the required
9 procedure for a local government to adopt a Comprehensive Plan, and Section 66.1001
10 (2) identifies the required elements of a Comprehensive Plan; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the Comprehensive Planning Oversight Committee has the
12 authority to recommend that the county Board of supervisors adopt a "Comprehensive
13 Plan" under Section 66.1001 (4)(b); and

14 **WHEREAS**, the Comprehensive Planning Oversight Committee has prepared
15 the attached County Comprehensive Plan document, containing all maps and other
16 descriptive materials, to be the Comprehensive Plan for Oneida County under Section
17 66.1001, Wisconsin Statutes.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**
19 **DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

20 Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in
21 conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.

22 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication
23 as required by law.

24 Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged
25 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this
26 ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

27 Section 4. Section Chapter 26 of the General Code of Oneida County,
28 Wisconsin, is amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by
29 strikethrough]:

31 Chapter 26 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

33 26.01 TITLE

34 Chapter 30 shall be known as the Oneida County Comprehensive Land Use Plan
35 Ordinance.

37 26.02 AUTHORITY

38 This chapter is adopted under authority granted by sections 59.69(2) and (3) and
39 66.1001, Wis. Stats.

41 26.03 ADOPTION OF COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

42 Pursuant to sec. 66.1001(4)(c), Wis. Stats., the Oneida County Board of Supervisors
43 does, by enactment of this ordinance, adopt the document entitled "Oneida County
44 Comprehensive Plan" including all maps and descriptive materials contained therein.
45 (Editors note: Copies of the Comprehensive Plan are on file at the Oneida County
46 Planning and Zoning Department.)

48 26.04 SEVERABILITY

49 The provisions of this ordinance and the Comprehensive Plan are severable. If any part
50 of this ordinance or the Comprehensive Plan is found to be invalid, unlawful, or
51 unenforceable, that finding will not affect the validity, lawfulness, or enforceability of the

52 remainder of this ordinance or the Comprehensive Plan, and the remainder of this
53 ordinance and the Comprehensive Plan shall remain in full force and effect.
