Sealed bids will be accepted by the Oneida County Forestry Department at the Oneida County Courthouse, Second Floor, Room B206, Rhinelander, WI 54501 **UNTIL NOON ON MONDAY, APRIL 29, 2019**. There are 15 tracts of timber for sale in the Towns of Cassian, Enterprise, Lake Tomahawk, Little Rice, Lynne, Nokomis, Pelican and Woodboro, comprising 1,270 acres. Total volume estimates are as follows:

The outside of the envelope must show the tract number and contractor name. Bids must include:

1. Tract number.
2. List of species to be cut and estimated volume.
3. Bid prices per Ton or MBF for each species and product.
4. Signature and address of each bidder.
5. A refundable bid bond in the form of check or cash must accompany each bid for the amount of 5% of the total bid value.

Successful bidders must provide proof of training to the State SFI standards at the time of contract signing. Minimum required deposit is 25% of successful bid value for each tract. The Forestry, Land & Recreation Committee reserves the right to reject any or all bids and/or select the bid most advantageous to Oneida County.

Bids will be publicly opened Monday, April 29, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. in Committee Room #1, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Oneida County Court House, Rhinelander, WI. Successful bids will be awarded at the regularly scheduled Oneida County Forestry, Land & Recreation Committee meeting at 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, May 1, 2019 in Committee Room #2 of the Oneida County Courthouse, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, Rhinelander, WI.
