RE: Opening of the Oneida County Snowmobile Trail System

The Oneida County Funded Snowmobile Trail System (as administered by the Oneida County Forestry, Land, & Recreation Department) is officially open for the 2018-2019 winter season. All funded trails within Oneida County are open; however, some trails remain in rough, early season condition.

All lake trails in Oneida County remain closed and are considered unsafe until they have been clearly marked by a local snowmobile club. As always, the Oneida County Forestry, Land, & Recreation Department recommends staying on clearly marked trails. Always exercise caution when riding a snowmobile.
