RE: Opening of the Oneida County Snowmobile Trail System

With one exception, the Oneida County Funded Snowmobile Trail System (as administered by the Oneida County Forestry, Land, & Recreation Department) will officially open for the 2018-2019 winter season at 5:00 pm on Saturday, December 29, 2018.

The following trail closure will be in effect until further notice:

**Three Lakes Trails:**

Funded Trail Corridor 13 is closed from TIN 122 (Rice Lake Rd) to TIN 022 (intersection north of Burnham Lk)

All lake trails in Oneida County remain closed and are considered unsafe until they have been clearly marked by a local snowmobile club. As always, the Oneida County Forestry, Land, & Recreation Department recommends staying on clearly marked trails. Always exercise caution when riding a snowmobile. The trails are in rough, early season condition.
