

# Oneida County Board of Canvas

## General Election

### November 6, 2018

Proceedings of the Oneida County Board of Canvass held in the County Clerk's Office, Election Conference Room, Oneida County Courthouse, First Floor, on Thursday, November 8, 2018 at 9:00 a.m., and on Friday, November 9, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. The purpose is to canvass the General Election held November 6, 2018.

Meeting Notice was posted November 7, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. on the Courthouse Bulletin Board by Tracy Hartman, County Clerk per Wis Stats. Media notified November 7, 2018 at 9:00 a.m., via mail/fax/email.

Present: Debra Neuman, Oneida County Deputy Clerk; Heidi Nehls, Oneida County Chief Deputy Clerk; Cindy Skinner, Town of Pine Lake Clerk; Virginia Stein, Town of Crescent Election Worker and Carla Fletcher, Town of Crescent Chief Election Inspector.

Meeting/Canvass was called to order by Cindy Skinner at 9:00 a.m. Poll lists with supplemental lists, absentee ballot logs, tally sheets, tapes, and Inspector's Statements will be reviewed. Voter/ballot numbers to be checked for accuracy and compared to election night report. Forms to be checked for signatures and correct completion. Notations will be made below and municipal clerks will be contacted. The Tabular Statement of Votes Cast will be filled in after each municipality is reviewed. Upon completion of the reviews, the election night results will be reconciled for any errors and the Summary Statement of the Board of Canvassers along with the Certification will be completed and signed by the board and will be made a part of these minutes. Entries will be made into WisVote and the printed Summary Statement and Certification will be signed and mailed to the Wisconsin Elections Commission. No Provisional Ballots were issued.

Heidi Nehls will take the minutes. Cindy Skinner, Virginia Stein, Debra Neuman and Carla Fletcher will review together each municipality and complete checklist.

**Town of Cassian** – Voters – 626/ Ballots Cast – 626  
The last number was not circled.

**Town of Crescent** (Wards 1, 2 & 3) – Voters- 1159/ Ballots Cast – 1159  
All reports signed and completed correctly.

**Town of Hazelhurst** – Voters – 802/ Ballots Cast – 802  
Absentee voters not counted or recorded. Inspectors Statement not filled out.

**Town of Lake Tomahawk** (Wards 1 and 2) – Voters – 614/ Ballots Cast – 614  
Rejected absentees not noted on Inspectors Statement. Two numbers not assigned to voters signature. Last voter number not circled.

**Town of Little Rice** – Voters – 207/ Ballots Cast – 207  
All reports signed and completed correctly.

**Town of Lynne** – Voters – 85/ Ballots Cast – 85  
Last voter number not circled in Poll Book.

**Town of Monico** – Voters – 119/ Ballots Cast – 119

Voter number was not listed by signature. Absentees not listed in red.

**Town of Nokomis** – Voters – 792/ Ballots Cast – 792

Voter was issued wrong voter number. There was a 5 vote discrepancy between tally tape and call in sheet.

**Town of Pelican** – Voters – 1385/ Ballots Cast – 1385

Tamper bag number missing. Absentee ballot rejected that should have been overridden.

**Town of Piehl** – Voters – 41/ Ballots Cast – 41

On the tally sheet the paper ballots were not differentiated between tally tape and paper.

**Town of Schoepke** – Voters – 221/ Ballots Cast – 221

All reports signed and completed correctly.

**Town of Sugar Camp** – Voters – 1040/ Ballots Cast – 1040

All reports signed and completed correctly.

**Town of Three Lakes** – Voters – 1417/ Ballots Cast – 1417

Missing signatures not documented on the Inspector's Statement.

**Town of Woodboro** – Voters – 497/ Ballots Cast – 497

Last voter number not circled. Chief Inspector not initialing security area. Clerk signed as inspector.

**Town of Minocqua** – Voters – 2965/ Ballots Cast – 2965

A page in the Supplemental Poll Book was missing after it was determined 7 voters were missing. EDR'S were missing residence verification, worker signature, voter number and DL expiration dates in the majority of applications. Duplicate voter numbers were issued. Page 47 and 260 were missing voters signatures.

Provisional added to tally sheet.

**Town of Newbold (Wards 2, 3 and 4)** – Voters – 1413/ Ballots Cast – 1413

Numbers in book wrong but count was correct.

All reports signed and completed correctly.

**Town of Stella** – Voters – 316/ Ballots Cast – 316

Municipal Board of Canvass reconvened to draw down a ballot.

**Town of Woodruff** – Voters – 1176/ Ballots Cast – 1176

Bag seal number missing.

**Town of Enterprise** – Voters – 217/ Ballots Cast – 217

Absentee voters need to be in red, letter “A” in front of absentee voter numbers.

**City of Rhinelander – Ward 1** – Voters – 358/ Ballots Cast – 358

Certification not complete.

**City of Rhinelander – (Wards 2 and 3)** – Voters – 365/ Ballots Cast – 365

No tally sheet completed. Absentee number corrected by election inspector on EL-104 but not on certificate page.

**City of Rhinelander – (Wards 4 and 5)** – Voters – 350/ Ballots Cast – 350

All reports signed and completed correctly.

**City of Rhinelander – (Wards 6 and 7)** – Voters – 320/ Ballots Cast – 320

No tally sheets for write-ins.

**City of Rhinelander – (Wards 8 and 9)** – Voters – 510/ Ballots Cast – 510

A zero was placed in the optical scan area. No tally sheets for write-ins. Rejected Absentee reason not listed on EL-104.

**City of Rhinelander – Ward 10** – Voters – 364/ Ballots Cast – 364

Incorrect voter number. Did not circle last voter number. No tally sheets for write-ins.

**City of Rhinelander – (Wards 11 and 12)** – Voters – 333/ Ballots Cast – 333

No tally sheets for write-ins.

**City of Rhinelander – (Wards 13 and 14)** – Voters – 361/ Ballots Cast – 361
