Resolution offered by Supervisors of the Planning and Zoning Committee.

Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, the Oneida County Board of Supervisors approved Resolution #12-2008;
and

WHEREAS, the Oneida County Board of Supervisors unanimously approved utilizing a
"Town Driven" plan or a bottom-up approach to develop Oneida County's Comprehensive Plan;
and

WHEREAS, in order to be effective and enforceable the County Plan must have internal
consistency; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Committee recommends that when a Town
develops a Comprehensive Plan that is incorporated County Comprehensive Plan, the County
shall make no substantive changes to the Town Comprehensive Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Oneida County Board of Supervisors
directs the North Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission that when a Town
Comprehensive Plan is incorporated into the County Comprehensive Plan, that the Town's
policies and intent be honored and that no substantive changes be made to the form of the plan
adopted by the Town.
