5 **Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:**

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7 **WHEREAS**, Oneida County currently seeks to relocate the Health Department to the
8 former WPS building ("Building") on Davenport Street; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Oneida County has paid \$525,000 for the Building; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the projected cost to remodel the Building to meet the needs of the Health
11 Department is approximately \$265,000;

12 **WHEREAS**, the utilities to operate the Building are approximately \$50,000 per year; and

13 **WHEREAS**, there was not a goal of new office space in the Health Department long
14 range plan; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the county plans to move the UW-Extension offices to the vacated Health
16 department offices in the Courthouse at a cost to the taxpayers to be determined later; and

17 **WHEREAS**, there is very little public support for the proposed Health Department move
18 and associated costs; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the taxpayers of Oneida County should not be burdened with the extra
20 expense of relocating the Health Department and the additional yearly costs; and

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Oneida County Board of Supervisors
22 does hereby halt the relocation of the Health Department.
