6 **Ordinance Amendment offered by Supervisors of the Finance & Insurance Committee**

7 **Whereas**, all financial institutions charge a fee for processing various financial
8 transactions, and

9 **Whereas**, the financial institutions also charge the County an additional fee for handling
10 checks that are written on accounts without sufficient funds, and

11 **Whereas**, the Finance & Insurance Committee has determined that a \$20 fee for
12 processing returned checks is appropriate.

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**
14 **DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

15 Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in conflict
16 with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.

17 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as
18 required by law.

19 Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged
20 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the
21 remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

22 Section 4. Section 3.16 of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is amended as
23 follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]:

25 **3.16 ISSUE OF WORTHLESS CHECKS.**

26 The County Board authorizes and directs the County Treasurer to charge a service fee of ~~\$15~~ \$20
27 for all checks returned by financial institutions due to insufficient funds.
