

1 **RESOLUTION # 26-2012**

2 Resolution offered by Labor Relations Employee Services Committee.

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5 **Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:**

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7 **WHEREAS**, Resolution #86-2007 did create a part time (60%) Environmental
8 Technician position in the Public Health Department, and
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10 **WHEREAS**, the Public Health Director reviewed and analyzed the Sanitarian Program
11 and did determine that there is a need to increase the Environmental Technician position by 2.5
12 hours per week, and
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14 **WHEREAS**, the Public Health Department has been awarded a grant that focuses on
15 Chronic Disease and supports an increase of 5 hours per week for the Environmental
16 Technician position, and
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18 **WHEREAS**, the Public Health Director recommended to the Labor Relations Employee
19 Services Committee that the Environmental Technician position be increased by 7.5 hours per
20 week or the equivalent of an 80% part time position with all funding to come from fees or grant
21 dollars. Should grant and/or fee funding increase or decrease the hours of the position shall be
22 automatically adjusted accordingly contingent upon approval of committee of jurisdiction and
23 Labor Relations and Employee Services committee.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors
26 that effective March 21, 2012 the part time Environmental Technician position in the Public
27 Health Department will be increased to 80% with all funding for the position to come from
28 revenues and grant dollars.
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30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors that by
31 adoption of this resolution it shall be deemed that an amendment has been made to the County
32 budget for fiscal year 2012 to reflect all projected costs for the position as set forth in the fiscal
33 impact statement which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
