WHEREAS, the County Clerk explained that this position is able to meet the needs of the office if decreased from 100% to 75%; and

WHEREAS, the Administration Committee did agree that the need for the position to remain full time does not exist and the position should be decreased to part time (75%).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors that effective January 1, 2018 that the full time Deputy Clerk position shall be decreased to a part time (75%) position; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors that by adoption of this resolution it shall be deemed that all projected costs for the positions as set forth in the fiscal impact statement which is attached hereto and made a part hereof shall come from the County Clerk's Office 2018 budget.
