ORDINANCE AMENDMENT # 5-2017
Ordinance Amendment offered by the Administration Committee
WHEREAS, Oneida County Code Section 2.02 sets forth the order of business
for meetings of the Oneida County Board: and
WHEREAS, the code should be amended for purposes of clarity and to comply
with Open Meetings law; and
WHEREAS, Oneida County Code section 2.19 states "Except where expressly
provided by the Wisconsin Statutes or by specific rules set forth in this chapter, the
deliberations of the Board and its boards, commissions and committees shall be
conducted in accordance with procedures set forth in: A Guide to Parliamentary
Procedure for Local Governments in Wisconsin by Larry E. Larmer. Robert's Rules of Order, newly revised, shall be consulted for any questions of procedure not addressed in
the above noted guide. Such guide shall be provided to each supervisory district and
shall remain the property of Oneida County."
WHEREAS, "A Guide to Parliamentary Procedure for Local Governments in
Wisconsin" by Larry E. Larmer, in section 4.7, states that the Chairperson is responsible
for meeting agendas;
WHEREAS, Oneida County Code should be amended to reflect the Chairperson
is responsible for the County Board Meeting agenda.
NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in
conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.
Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication
as required by law.
Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged
unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the
remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
Section 4. Section 2.02 of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is
amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]:
2.02 RULE 2: ORDER OF BUSINESS. (Am. #51-94; #72-94; #20-2008)
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The order of business shall be as follows: at the discretion of the County Board Chairperson.
(1) CALL TO ORDER. At the appointed hour for the meeting, the Chair shall call the Board
to order requesting that the members rise for a brief moment of silence followed by the
Pledge of Allegiance.
(2) ROLL CALL. The Clerk shall then call the roll of members in alphabetical order.
(3) ANNOUNCEMENTS BY THE CHAIR, CORRESPONDENCE AND COMMUNICATION.
(4) ACCEPT MINUTES OF PREVIOUS COUNTY BOARD MEETING(S).
(5) REPORTS
