COUNTY BOARD SUPERVISOR FOR DISTRICT 1**

The Oneida County Board of Supervisors is seeking one (1) thoughtful, civic minded, energetic community member to serve on the County Board of Supervisors District 1 (Wards 3, 4, 7 & 9 in the City of Rhineland) Residency in Rhineland, Wards 3, 4, 7 or 9 is required to be considered for this vacancy.

The appointed individual will serve on the Oneida County Board of Supervisors and various Committees for the remainder of the term which ends April 2024. Members play a critical role in shaping the direction of programs and services for county citizens.

The County Board meets monthly, currently on the morning of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month. The board is comprised of twenty-one elected supervisors representing each of the districts in the County. The general powers of the County Board are provided under Wis. Stats.59.51 and are exercised through the resolutions and ordinances it adopts. The Board acts similarly to the state legislature in that it is a policy-making body of the County government. It establishes County ordinances, levies taxes and appropriates money for services. County Board Supervisors are expected to attend all meetings of the County Board and committees, boards and commissions they are appointed to.
