Proceedings of the Oneida County Board of Canvass held in the County Clerk's Office, Oneida County Courthouse, First Floor, on Thursday, August 13, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. The purpose is to canvass the Partisan Primary Election held on August 11, 2020.

Meeting Notice was posted August 12, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. on the Courthouse Bulletin Board by Tracy Hartman, County Clerk per Wis Stats. Media notified August 12, 2020 at 9:00 a.m., via mail/fax/email.

Meeting/Canvass was called to order on Thursday, August 13, 2020 by Cindy Skinner at 9:00 a.m.

Present: Cindy Skinner, Town of Pine Lake Clerk; Carla Fletcher, Town of Crescent Chief Election Inspector; Heidi Nehls, Chief Deputy Clerk; Tracy Hartman, County Clerk.

Poll lists with supplemental lists, absentee ballot logs, tally sheets, tapes, and Inspector's Statements will be reviewed. Voter/ballot numbers to be checked for accuracy and compared to election night report. Forms to be checked for signatures and correct completion. Notations will be made below and municipal clerks will be contacted. The Tabular Statement of Votes Cast will be filled in after each municipality is reviewed.
