## Spring Primary

### February 15, 2022

Proceedings of the Oneida County Board of Canvass held in the County Clerk's Office, Oneida County Courthouse, First Floor, on Thursday, February 17, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. The purpose is to canvass the February Spring Primary held February 15, 2022.

Meeting Notice was posted February 15, 2022, at 8:00 a.m. on the Courthouse Bulletin Board by Tracy Hartman, County Clerk per Wis Stats. Media notified February 15, 202 at 8:00 a.m., via mail/fax/email.

Meeting/Canvass was called to order on Thursday, February 17, 2022 by Cindy Skinner at 1:00 p.m.

**Present:** Cindy Skinner, Town of Pine Lake Clerk; Debra Neuman, Deputy Clerk; Heidi Nehls, Chief Deputy Clerk.

Poll lists with supplemental lists, absentee ballot logs, tally sheets, tapes, and Inspector's Statements will be reviewed. Voter/ballot numbers to be checked for accuracy and compared to election night report. Forms to be checked for signatures and correct completion. Notations will be made below and municipal clerks will be contacted. The Tabular Statement of Votes Cast will be filled in after each municipality is reviewed. Upon completion of the reviews, the election night results will be reconciled for any errors and the Summary Statement of the Board of Canvassers along with the Certification will be completed and signed by the board and will be made a part of these minutes. Entries will be made into WisVote and the printed Summary Statement and Certification will be signed and mailed to the Wisconsin Elections Commission. No Provisional Ballots were issued.

**City of Rhinelander – (Ward 1)** – Voters – 10/ Ballots Cast – 8  
Inspectors Statement not correct regarding ballot and voter numbers. Ballots were given out incorrectly.

**City of Rhinelander – (Wards 2)** – Voters – 17/ Ballots Cast – 16  
Inspectors Statement not correct regarding ballot and voter numbers. Ballots were given out incorrectly. Absentee should not have been considered rejected as they were never used.

**City of Rhinelander – (Wards 3)** – Voters – 66/ Ballots Cast – 69  
Inspectors Statement not correct regarding ballot and voter numbers. Ballots were given out incorrectly.

**City of Rhinelander – (Wards 4)** – Voters – 40/ Ballots Cast – 40  
All reports signed and completed correctly.
