

Notes made at the Manure Storage Ordinance Review Meeting held on Thursday, September 2, 2021 – 1:00 p.m.

Attendance by Zoom: Bob Mott, Michele Sadauskas, Dan Butkus, Karl Jennrich, Tom Jerow, Robert Thome, & Becky Gaskill

- There was general agreement with the modifications made at the request of Mr. Engle
- It was felt that the modifications addressed Mr. Engle's concerns but that Karl J. will contact and confirm.
- The Setbacks section was modified for clarity and to prevent covered temporary manure stacks from being located less than 250 from navigable waterways, and less than 100 ft of a wetland. (Michele S. concern)
- Mr. Mott's concerns on how to enforce both the 180 days max storage and setback locations were addressed - enforcement through complaints.
- Mr. Mott asked that Karl talk with Art Hilgendorf in LIO to generate some map overlays for how these setbacks affect existing farms.
- It appears ready for DATCP review once Karl's dept "cleans it up"
- Once back from DATCP review, Mr Fugle, Corp Counsel will review.
- It appears ready for review by the Conservation Committee on 9/13
- Mr. Mott will decide whether to forward it to P&D Committee or have that Committee review it during public hearings.
- We are only slightly behind the August target for DATCP submission
